PRIORITIES

SNT officers along with our ward panel members have come up with some priority issues for us to work on calming.

Drug offences - Sadly we have seen a rise in drug offences across the ward, with reports coming mainly around the open spaces within the ward. Officers have increased patrols around these areas in aid to tackle these offences taking place. We are trying to be in the areas such as Wandle Park, Waddon Ponds, etc. more often and we are organising an opportunity for anyone to join us for a walk around the ward in the coming months.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) - In line with an increase in drug use in the ward we have seen a rise in ASB. We have had quite a few reports in the Waddon Ponds and Wandle Park areas.

This month, Waddon SNT got the chance to celebrate alongside the people in our ward at the street parties for the King's Coronation. It was so lovely to see so many of you there.

We also got the chance to spend more time with the lovely councillors looking after Waddon by going on a walk around the ward. When doing so they told us some of the issues that they have had raised to them by yourselves and we did the same for them. We are hoping to make these a more regular occurrence and anybody is welcome to join us for these walks.
