PRIORITIES

VIOLENCE AGAINST THE PERSON:

We had no physical assault reported in April however domestic incidents were brought to the attention of police .We will continue to increase our visibility patrol and reassurance visits where possible.

Drugs: we had 2 drugs related offences reported in April (possession of cannabis) while officers were on mobile patrol, officer perceived a strong smell of cannabis from a vehicle parked, both suspects were detained and searched under section 23 of the misuse of drugs act. We continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our patrols both on foot and mobile in a more needed area.

Vehicle Crime: We had 4 vehicle crimes reported to the Safer Neighbourhood Team in March (2 theft from a motor vehicle 2 theft of a motor vehicle). Suspects are using various methods to gain entry to vehicles to steal items from vehicles or steal vehicles. The team will continue to work with residents where information is provided to concentrate our patrols in

HOW TO KEEP YOUR VEHCLE SAFE

Check for cloning before owning your car

Lock your vehicle

Keep the keys safe

Be aware of carjacker

Fit in good in-car security locks

Put the keys in a screened or signal-blocking pouch, such as a Faraday Bag and check if the bag or pouch is still working every few months.
